NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Banning, California, will hold a public hearing at its meeting of January 13, 2026. The City Council meeting begins at 5:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 99 East Ramsey Street, Banning, CA 92220. The purpose of this hearing is to consider application by Tri Pointe Homes (Applicant) for a Tentative Tract Map application (TTM39262/PTM25-0005) to subdivide 9 parcels located in the Low Density Residential (LDR) and Medium Density Residential (MDR) land use districts of the Butterfield Specific Plan, totaling 68.74 acres, into 193 single-family detached residential lots, in Planning Areas 50A and 51 (43.03 acres) with minimum lot sizes from 4,700 to 5,000 square feet, a 1.19-acre lettered lot for a park, and two lettered lots totaling 16.53 acres for open space and stormwater drainage areas in the Southern California Edison (SCE) corridor in Planning Area 74, with an existing water tank in Planning Area 75 and a new water tank in Planning Area 52A, at the northeast corner of Highland Home Road and the SCE corridor (APN 408-580-042, -051, -052, -053, -054, -055, -056, -063, -064)

The Planning Commission reviewed the subject project at its meeting of December 3, 2025, and voted 2 to 1 to recommend approval of the application to the City Council by adopting Resolution 2025-14.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed project was evaluated under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines and it was determined that the project is in compliance with the previously adopted Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Butterfield Specific Plan (SCH No. 2007091194) and is subject to the adopted Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program found here <https://banningca.gov/ArchiveCenter/ViewFile/Item/1877>. Pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 (Subsequent EIRs and Negative Declarations) no further analysis or environmental action is required. A Notice of Determination has been prepared for the project.

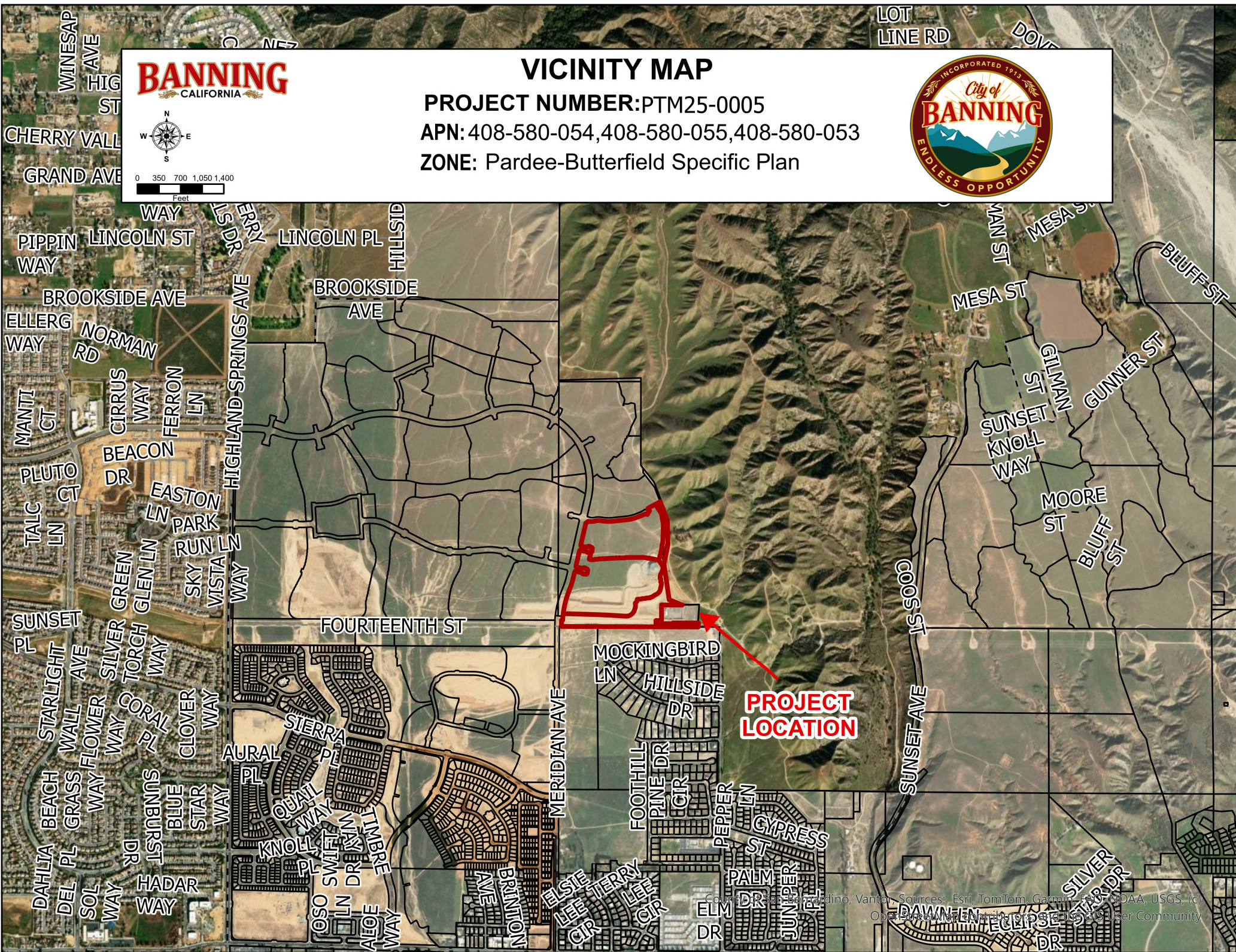
