

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE MITIGATED **DECLARATION** AND MITIGATION, MONITORING, AND REPORTING PROGRAM; **APPROVING** TENTATIVE TRACT MAP NO. 15-4501 (TTM 36939) A PROPOSAL TO SUBDIVIDE 34.6 ACRES OF VACANT LAND FOR PURPOSES OF CREATING 98 NUMBERED LOTS FOR SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT AND THREE (3) LETTERED LOTS; AND, APPROVING ZONE CHANGE NO. 15-3501 AMENDING THE ZONING MAP TO ELIMINATE THE RL-10,000 OVERLAY AFFECTING THE WESTERN PORTION OF THE SITE TO LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (LDR, 0 TO 5 UNITS PER ACRE); APN'S 535-430-001 THRU 021, 535-431-001 THRU 015, 535-432-001 THRU 017, 535-070-004 AND 006

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a public hearing before the City of Banning Planning Commission, to be held on Wednesday, January 6, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 99 East Ramsey Street, Banning, California, to consider the proposed Tentative Tract Map 36939, to create 98 numbered lots and 3 lettered lots and rezoning to amend the zoning map to eliminate the RL-10,000 overlay affecting the western portion of the site to Low Density Residential (0-5 du/ac). The subject parcels are located generally north of Wilson Street and east of Sunset Avenue in the City of Banning.
