July 18 – August 12	Nomination Period	Between these dates candidates may obtain and file nomination papers with the Deputy City Clerk Tuesday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A Declaration of Candidacy MUST be accompanied by the Ballot Designation Worksheet.
	Code of Fair Campaign Practices	*OPTIONAL* At the time a candidate is issued nomination papers each candidate will be issued a Code of Fair Campaign Practices. Filing it is voluntary and it may be filed any time before the election. It is available for public inspection until 30 days after the election.
August 12	Last Day to Withdraw Nomination Papers	There will be a 10-day examination period for filed Candidate Statements from August 13 through August 22.
August 15	Last Day to Withdraw Candidate Statements	The last day to withdraw candidate statements unless there is an extension of the nomination period. Withdrawal of candidate statements must be in writing to the Deputy City Clerk.

August 17	Extension of Nomination Period	If nomination papers for an incumbent are not filed by August 12, the voters shall have until August 17 to nominate candidates other than incumbent. Should this occur, there will be a 10-day examination period for Candidate Statements filed from August 18 through August 27; and Candidate Statements may be withdrawn through August 18.
August 22	City to Publish Nominees	After the Secretary of State conducts an alphabet drawing to determine the order of candidates' names on the ballot, the Deputy City Clerk will publish the list of nominations to offices in the election.
September 12	First Day Nomination Papers for Write-In Candidacy Will Be Available	Any qualifying person wishing to file as a write-in candidate may pick up nomination papers beginning on this date. Papers must be filed with the City Clerk no later than 14 days before Election Day. Write-in candidates must also file Statement of Economic Interest and campaign disclosure statements.
September 25-29	Filing Period for First Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement	The filing period for 1st pre-election campaign statement covers transactions through September 24. Statements must be filed online or sent by personal delivery or first-class mail.
October 23-27	Filing Period for Second Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement	The filing period for 2nd pre-election campaign statement covers transactions through October 22. Statements must be filed online or sent by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service.
October 24	Last Day of Voter Registration for Election	
October 25	File Declaration of Write-In Candidacy	The last day for write-in candidates to submit their write-in nomination papers including petitions to the City Clerk.
November 8	Election Day	
January 1-31	Filing Period for Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement	The statement covers transactions through December 31. Statements must be filed online or sent by personal delivery or first-class mail.
