

The City of Banning is accepting proposals for a city-owned commercial property located at 33 S. San Gorgonio Avenue, Banning, CA 92220. Otherwise known as Riverside County, CA APN 540-204-009. The property is within the Downtown Commercial Zone and the existing 1,920 s.f. structure was built in 1932. The City is interested in proposals that include active use of the property, generate tax revenue for the City, and promote a vibrant downtown atmosphere.



The subject property is a ±3,049-ft² site located on the west side of S San Gorgonio Avenue, south of Ramsey Street, in Banning, CA. The commercial site is improved with a single story, ±1,920-ft² single-tenant commercial building originally constructed the mid-1940s with limited remodeling occurring over the years. The single-story block/brick/wood-frame and stucco-sided building has concrete floors and exposed brick and drywall interior walls. The building includes a single bathroom, office and small mezzanine area located in the western portion of the building.

Access to the property is from the west side of San Gorgonio Avenue. The property is northerly adjacent to public parking and there is some street parking available. The property is considered to be in fair to average condition with an estimated age of ± 40 years with a remaining economic life of ± 15 years.
