On Thursday, January 31, 2019, at approximately 2039 hours, Banning Police Dispatch received a call in regards to a subject that had been stabbed. Officers were dispatched to the 300 block of East George Street, in the City of Banning.

Upon officer's arrival, they contacted the victim, a 26-year-old Hispanic male adult who had sustained a single stab wound to his back. The victim advised he was riding his scooter westbound on East George Street, when he was approached by an unknown male subject dressed in all black clothing riding a bicycle. The victim stated that the unknown male subject stabbed him for an unknown reason. The victim walked to a friend's house a few hundred yards away from where the incident occurred and had his friend call 9-1-1 for him.

Officers searched the area for the suspect and evidence but were unable to locate the suspect, evidence, or a crime scene. Cal Fire and AMR responded to the location to render aid. The victim was transported to Desert Regional Memorial Hospital in Palm Springs for medical treatment. The victim's condition is unknown at this time.
