Contract With Riverside County Animal Services Expires June 30 Stray Pets Heading to Banning Animal Shelter July 1

A contract between Riverside County Animal Services and the City of Banning expires on June 30.

That means the county's animal control officers will not be patrolling Banning city limits starting July 1. City of Banning Animal Control Officers will be taking over patrol and enforcement responsibilities effective July 1.

Pet owners seeking to reunite with their pets should check for their lost animal at www.arerescue.org or visit the shelter, located at 2244 Charles Street, Banning, CA 92220.

Stray animals that have been impounded previously – and up to June 30 – will be transported to this facility.
