As part of your automated pick-up service, WM provides 96-gallon trash, recycling, and organic waste carts.

Cart Service Reminders

1. Place all waste in the appropriate container and close the lid.
2. All trash, recyclables, and organic waste outside the cart will not be collected.
3. Place your carts at the curb by 6:00 am on collection day. Emptied carts must be removed from curbside by 6:00 pm on the same day.
4. Roll carts into the street and place them against the curb, handles facing your home. Place carts at least two feet apart from other carts and objects.

Note: Additional trash, recycling and organic waste carts are available for a nominal rate. Contact WM at (800) 423-9986 for more information. Residents with a cracked or broken trash, recycling, or organic waste cart are eligible for a free replacement.

Billing

Residential services are billed monthly by WM.

Community Clean-Up Days

Waste Management will host three community clean-up days per year. E-Waste collection and document shredding will be available during each event. Customers will receive notification of scheduled dates with their bill prior to the event.

Bulky Item, Electronic Waste & Extra Organic Waste Collection

Residents with curbside cart service may request three times in a calendar year, the free pickup of household bulky items, electronic waste and extra organic waste (not to exceed 1.5 cubic yards of bundled solid waste, six large items or ten 32-gallon bags). Additional bulky item pickups are available at a nominal cost.

Bulky items include couches, washers, dryers, and refrigerators. Bulky items do not include large items such as car bodies or construction and demolition waste, tires, hazardous waste, or any other items that cannot be handled by two persons. Sharps Home Delivery

Residents receive one (1) free Sharps container per calendar year. To request your Sharps container, please call WM to place your order and one will be delivered to your home. Each container comes with a pre-paid postal approved return box.

Collection service will be delayed one day following these holidays. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delays.



Christmas Tree & Cardboard Recycling

Waste Management will collect and recycle Christmas trees and extra cardboard, starting on December 26, for two (2) consecutive weeks at no additional charge.



- Trees longer than six (6) feet must be cut in half.
- Please remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands.
- Flocked trees will be collected by the trash truck but cannot be recycled.
- Cardboard that is not able to fit in the recycle cart can be collected during this two-week period if it is flattened and bundled and placed at the curb with the carts.



Used Motor Oil/Filter & Tire Collection

Waste Management offers free pickup of residentially generated used motor oil (maximum of two gallons per month and up to three used motor oil filters per month).

The program also includes collection of up to eight used tires per year. Please contact WM customer service at (800) 423-9986 at least 24 hours in advance of your regular collection day to schedule.
